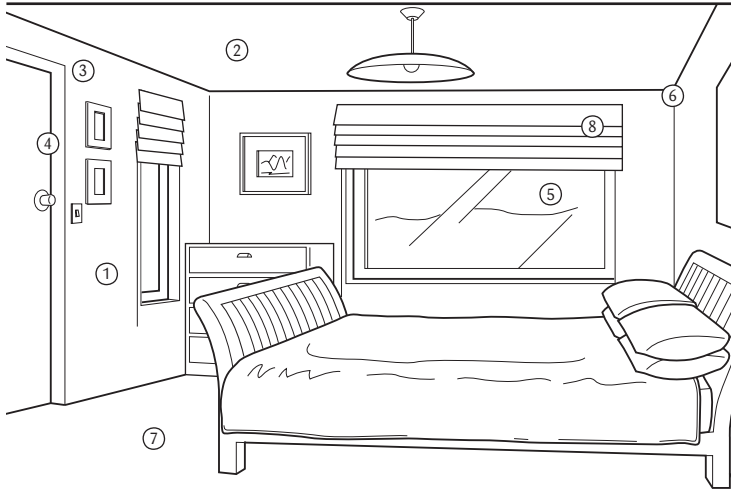



Bedrooms/Study/Office/Home Cinema Room

 Noise from internal and external sources. Cold and dampness from lack of insulation or poor room orientation. Lack of power points, light switches and lighting and outdated appearance.

RECOMMENDATIONS:
 Remove old linings. Install additional power points, light switches and lighting. Install a GIB Quiet Zone®, including insulation for warmth. Add new features, colours and furnishings.
