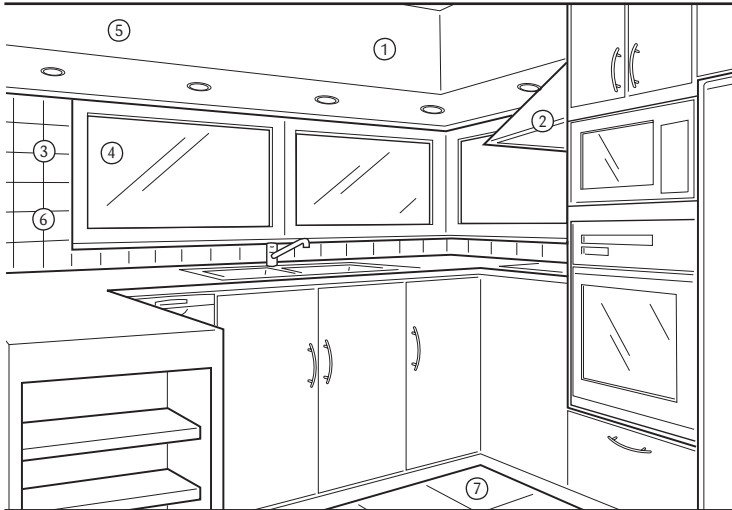


Kitchen
